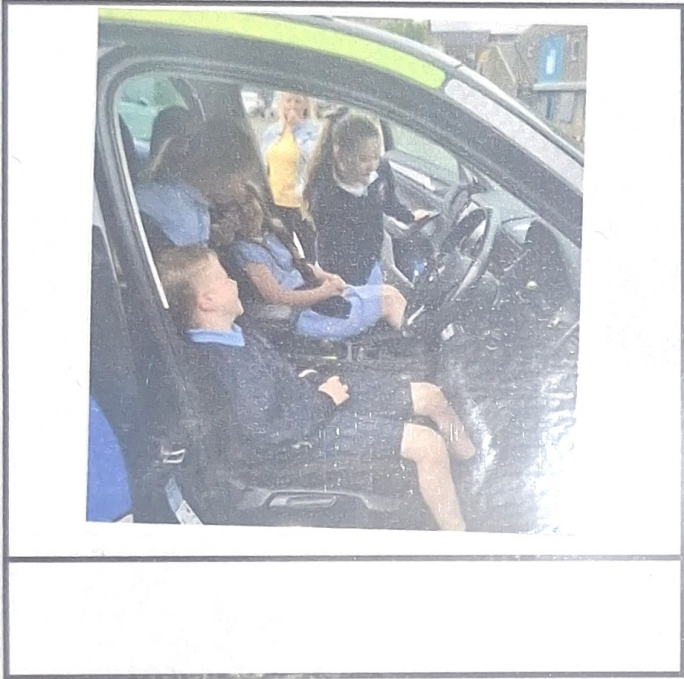

..... My favourite thing • to dissect

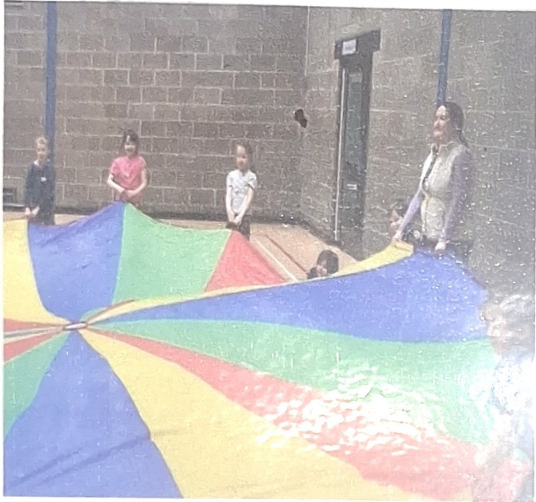

.....I like Piano..... lessons!

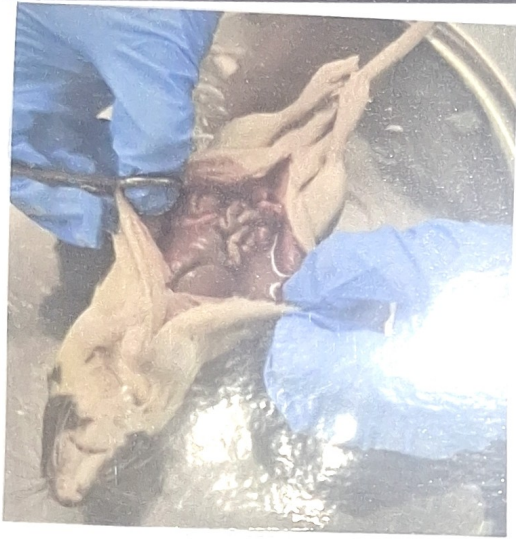

..... A Little Squeaky !



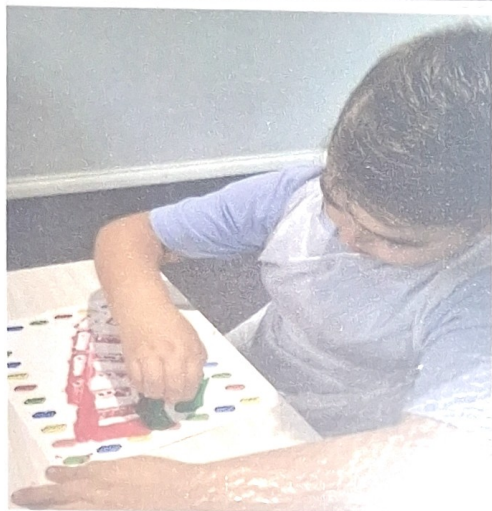
So much fun!

Hot Cross Buns together!

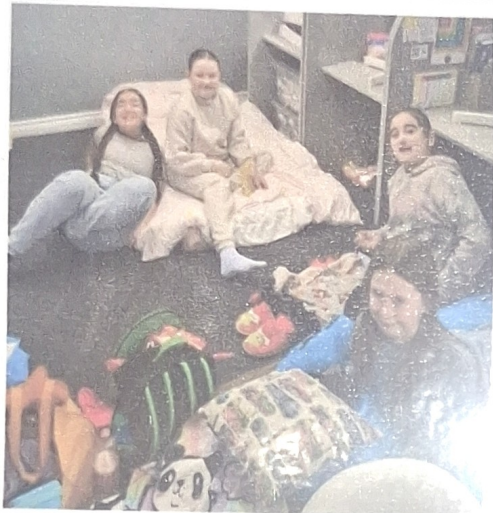
..... Brilliant Bricks!

fire station!

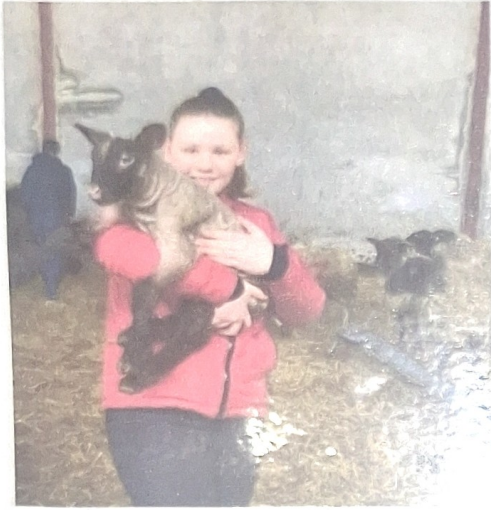
